VIEW RESOURCES LIMITED APPOINTS NEW CEO

The Board of View Resources Limited (VRE) announces that Mr. Derek Lenartowicz has resigned from his position as Managing Director and as a Director of the company. Mr Lenartowicz has managed the growth of View Resources over the past three years and most notably he brought the Bronzewing asset into the company in 2003, but he has decided to move on and focus on personal projects. His resignation is effective immediately.

Mr Lenartowicz commented "The Company has moved into a new operational phase of its development and it is time for a change. The current management team we have built up within View is very capable of driving the company forward from here and this allows me to step aside and concentrate on other projects."

Mr. Tim Gooch, who until now was the Chief Operating Officer, will take over as the new CEO. With the company rapidly moving toward establishing a sizeable gold operation based at Bronzewing Mr Gooch's operational experience puts him in a very good position to lead the company to achieve its short to medium term objectives.

Mr Gooch is a qualified Mining Engineer with over 25 years experience in the mining industry, gained locally in Australia as well as working overseas. Companies he has worked for include BGC Contracting, Jubilee Mines, Ashanti Goldfields and Australian Resources. Mr Gooch has previous experience in the central W.A. region as General Manager at Jubilee's Cosmos Nickel Mine and the Mt McClure Gold Mine for Australian Resources.

Mr Gooch added "View is well positioned to take advantage of the current strong markets as it moves into production at Bronzewing. We have a significant asset and we want to maximise its potential in the short term to lock in value and thus ensure the future of the company."

View Resources is currently completing the final stages of its feasibility study for Bronzewing and the intention remains to commence the production phase by mid-2006. As a result of this feasibility work View recently announced a significantly increased indicated resource at Bronzewing.

The Board wishes to thank Mr Lenartowicz for his contributions over the last three years and wishes him well in his future endeavours
