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AMT Awarded Major Contract for Rollout of Collision Avoidance Technology

INDUSTREA Group's (ASX: **IDL**) wholly owned subsidiary Advanced Mining Technologies Pty Ltd (AMT) has been awarded a major contract with BHP Billiton Mitsubishi Alliance (BMA) to fit CAS-CAM collision avoidance technology to the mobile equipment fleet at all BMA surface coal mining operations in the Bowen Basin, Queensland. The installation includes the Peak Downs, Saraji, Norwich Park, Gregory, Blackwater and Goonyella Riverside mines.

The AMT Collision Avoidance Camera System (CAS-CAM) improves operator visibility by eliminating blind spots around heavy surface mobile equipment. Incidents involving poor visibility for drivers are a major source of reportable safety incidents in surface mining operations every year. The introduction of CAS-CAM technology significantly improves the safety of employees and reduces production and operation losses as a direct result of safety related incidents involving mobile equipment on mining sites.

After trials of CAS-CAM at BMA's Blackwater mine and an extensive review of other types of collision prevention technologies, BMA have selected CAS-CAM as the most suitable system to reduce the potential for collisions between heavy surface mobile equipment, light vehicles and stationary objects at BMA sites in the Bowen Basin.

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INDUSTREA Group Managing Director and Chief Executive Officer, Mr Robin Levison said, "The BMA contract demonstrates that AMT's collision avoidance technology has reached a critical level of market acceptance and is gaining traction among the world's major mining companies."

"The awarding of this contract follows the successful rollout of the CAS-CAM technology at Anglo's Collahuasi mine in Chile and the installation of trial equipment at mine sites in Australia, Indonesia and South America with a number of major multi-national mining companies."

Preparations for the project commenced in June 2006. The rollout will be managed by a Site Steering Group comprising BMA and contract mining representatives led by a full-time AMT project co-ordinator. The rollout incorporates three phases:

Phase One: CAS-CAM Camera System rollout

Phase Two: Full mine site trial implementation of CAS-CAM/RF (incorporating automatic radio frequency identification of vehicles) at a BMA pilot site

Phase Three: Rollout of CAS-CAM/RF across all BMA surface coal mining operations after successful completion of Phase Two.
