He will draw on his experience both in France and internationally to support synergies across various markets and accelerate the company's global expansion. Gilles joined Mersen in 2015 as Executive Vice President of the Electrical Power segment. Over the years, he has successfully expanded the segment through acquisitions and organic growth, while improving its profitability.

These changes will take effect on January 1, 2026.
