Lindab receives SEK 12 million ventilation order in Hungary

Lindab has signed contracts for the supply of the ventilation and indoor climate system to the new 80.000m² manufacturing facilities for LEGO in the city of Nyíregyháza, Hungary. The order, worth over SEK 12 million, will be delivered according to a tight schedule from July until September this year.
