Lindab has reached an agreement to acquire the French company Froid Partn'Air, distributor of ventilation and indoor climate products in the Marseille region in France. The acquisition strengthens Lindab's presence and distribution in this area, which is the third most populated area in France. The annual turnover amounts to approx. SEK 13 m and the company employs 5 people.

"Our distribution model with fully-owned branches gives us a competitive advantage in terms of close customer relations and a unique knowledge of our customers' requirements. This acquisition strengthens our geographical presence in an important local area in France."
