



Substantial new order for Sweco: Awarded water supply project in Jordan worth 12.7 million euros

Sweco has been awarded a record order in connection with a Jordanian initiative to improve access to drinking water in the country's capital city Amman. The order is one of Sweco's largest water-related contracts.

Jordan is currently struggling with a severe water shortage. The new water supply system will pump water along a 350 km water pipeline to the capital city. Sweco has been commissioned for project management and supervision of the large-scale construction project. The assignment will be carried out directly for the Jordanian Government's Ministry of Water and Irrigation, and will run for the next four years. When completed, the water supply system will provide Amman's population of 2.5 million residents with almost half of their water requirements.

Facts:

The new water supply system will pump water from an aquifer in Rum in southern Jordan and transport it to Amman via a 350 km water pipeline. The water will be extracted from 55 wells drilled to a depth of around 600 meters.

The project is being carried out according to a BOT (Build Operate Transfer) approach in which a concessionaire will design, build and manage the pipeline for a period of 25 years, after which the project will be transferred to the client, the Ministry of Water and Irrigation.
