BioGaia product launched as pharmaceutical in India

BioGaia has signed an agreement with Tablets India Ltd. for the production and sale of products based on BioGaia's probiotics on the Indian market. The launch is planned in the first half of 2009.

The first product to be launched on the Indian market is a capsule under the brand name Apylori Probiotic Capsules. The product is manufactured by Tablets India and registered as a pharmaceutical which will be prescribed by physicians and distributed through pharmacies.

We know that the Indian market is very large and fragmented and it is thus of great importance for BioGaia to enter an agreement with a well-established partner with long experience.
