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Change to the number of shares and votes in Rottneros AB (publ)

The number of shares and votes in Rottneros AB (publ) ("the Company") increased by 31 in April 2010 as a consequence of the directed share issue in the Company, which was resolved at the AGM on 22 April 2010. The number of shares and votes in the Company following the share issue amounted to 1,533,938,900 and the share capital of the Company amounted to SEK 153,393,890.

For the purpose of information, it may also be mentioned that the reverse share split resolved at the AGM was registered at the Swedish Companies Registration Office in April. This reverse split means that ten (10) existing shares have been combined as one (1) share. This means that the number of shares and votes in the Company was 153,393,890 on 30 April 2010 and that the share capital amounts to SEK 153,393,890. However, shareholders should note that this change will only be executed by Euroclear Sweden AB in the company's register of shareholders and in the shareholders' VP accounts after the record day for the reverse split, which is 7 May 2010. The first day of trading with the reverse split share is 5 May 2010.

Rottneros is an independent producer of market pulp. The Group comprises the parent company Rottneros AB, listed on NASDAQ OMX Stockholm, and its subsidiaries Rottneros Bruk AB and Vallviks Bruk AB with operations involving the production and sale of market pulp. The Group also includes the wood procurement company Rottneros Baltic SIA in Latvia and the sales company Rottneros S.A. in Belgium. The Rottneros Packaging AB division produces food packaging made from paper pulp. The Group has around 350 employees and had a turnover of approximately SEK 1.5 billion in the 2009 financial year.
