TransAtlantic acquires Merilinja operations

TransAtlantic has acquired the operations of the Finnish shipping company Merilinja. This is an asset deal where TransAtlantic purchases substantially all of Merilinja's assets and assumes Merilinja's chartered-in vessels. Included in Merilinja's assets are its customer contracts.

Merilinja offers feeder services within container shipping between Finland (Kokkola and Oulu) and Antwerp with revenues of approximately SEK 100 M per year.

"We are very excited to acquire Merilinja's broad and sizable customer base. Combined with TransAtlantic existing activities, this gives us a unique opportunity to improve our competitiveness between northern Finland and Belgium.", says Heléne Mellquist CEO Industrial Shipping, TransAtlantic." This in turn will enable us to increase and improve our services in this market to existing as well as new customers. We should also be able to grow this business based on the improved competitive position."
