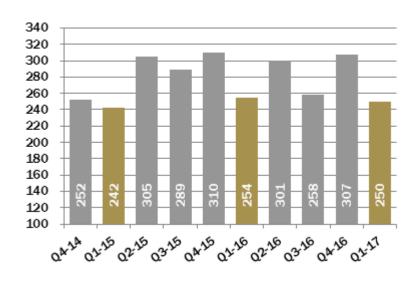

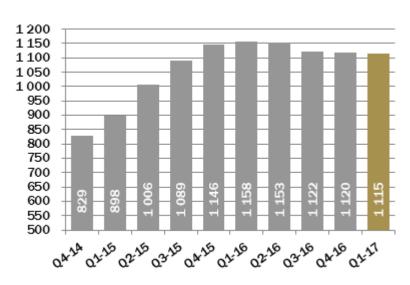




#### Revenues per quarter

#### 12 months rolling



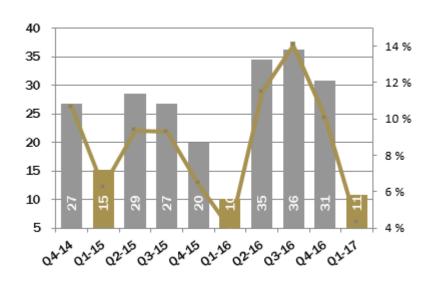


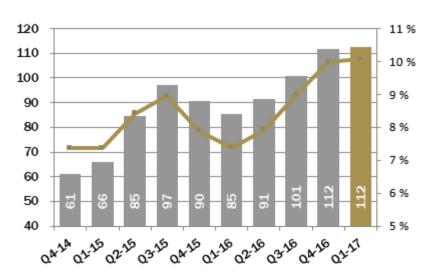




#### **EBITDA** per quarter

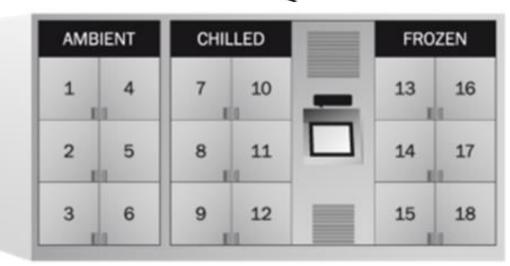
