TomTom's HD Traffic™ navigation system combines the world's most accurate traffic information with dynamic route guidance technology. HD Traffic™ information is the most accurate in the world. It covers more road kilometres on both secondary and main roads. It reports traffic jams with higher accuracy and also refreshes more frequently than any other service. Drivers can also use TomTom's HD Traffic™ information online to plan their journey around a time when their route is less busy and in doing so will further reduce congestion.

TomTom outlines its mission - to reduce traffic congestion for everyone - as part of its Traffic Manifesto. The Manifesto outlines four key action areas, designed to accelerate mass adoption of intelligent route guidance systems. TomTom will continue to work with individuals, businesses, organisations and governments to see the full scope of its plans become a reality. The four commitments outlined in the Manifesto are:

1. We will encourage and inspire people to play a role in reducing traffic congestion.
2. We will increase the availability of TomTom HD Traffic™.
3. We will lead the continuous improvement of traffic and route guidance technology.
4. We will bring together key traffic stakeholders to share ideas and drive actions forward.
