Ageas reports on the progress of share buy-back programme

Further to the initiation of the share buy-back programme announced on 8 August 2018, Ageas reports the purchase of 105,500 Ageas shares on Euronext Brussels in the period from 22-10-2018 until 26-10-2018.

Since the start of the share buy-back programme on 13 August 2018, Ageas has bought back 1,051,938 shares for a total amount of EUR 46,912,223. This corresponds to 0.52% of the total shares outstanding.
