Repurchase and disposal of own shares

In accordance with articles 8:4 and 8:6 of the Royal Decree of 29 April 2019 implementing the Code on Companies and Associations, D'leteren Group announces today the purchase and disposal of treasury shares on the regulated market of Euronext Brussels and / or an MTF between 16 and 22 October 2024.

The extraordinary shareholders' meeting of D'Ieteren Group renewed on 25 May 2023 the powers of the Board of Directors to acquire and dispose of own shares for a period of 5 years.

The total number of own shares held by D'leteren Group reached 623,659 (1.2%) on 22 October 2024. The total number of ordinary shares equals 53,708,999.
