

Repurchase of own shares in the context of the liquidity contract

In the framework of the liquidity contract (see press release dated Mar. 1st, 2016), Proximus announces today that Kepler-Cheuvreux on behalf of Proximus has bought 123.020 own shares during the period between 13 January 2020 and 17 January 2020 on Euronext Brussels.

During the same period, Kepler-Cheuvreux on behalf of Proximus has sold 112.500 own shares and consequently this results in a net increase of 10.520 own shares.
