

BOLOGNA AIRPORT: 775,000 PASSENGERS IN NOVEMBER (+9.4%)

Since the beginning of the year, total passengers have already exceeded 10 million

Another month of growth for Bologna Airport. In November, Marconi passengers reached 775,427, with a 9.4% increase over the same month of 2024.

In detail, **passengers on international flights** were 598,670 (+10.7% on November 2024), while **passengers on domestic flights** were 176,757 (+5.1% on the same month of 2024). **Movements** were 5,520 (+5.7%), while **freight** were 3,683 tons, a reduction of '1.0%.

Favorite destinations for November 2025 were, in order: Catania, Tirana, Barcelona, Madrid, Paris Charles de Gaulle, Istanbul, Palermo, London Heathrow, Bucharest Otopeni and Amsterdam. **The busiest day of the month was Monday, November 3**, with 34,565 passengers arriving and departing.

In the January-November period, the Marconi's total passengers were 10,346,085, with an increase of 3.0% over the same period of 2024. With this result, **Bologna Airport has already exceeded the total of 10 million passengers per year**. There were 73,153 movements in the first 11 months of 2025, up 3.0% over the corresponding period of 2024. Freight in the first 11 months of 2025 was 40,492 tons, down (-3.3%) compared to 2024.

Aeroporto Guglielmo Marconi di Bologna, classified as a "strategic airport" in the centre-north area of the National Airports Plan prepared by the Ministry of Infrastructure and Transport, recorded in 2024 10.8 million passengers, ranking as the seventh biggest Italian airport by number of passengers (Source: Assaeroporti – Aeroporti2030). Located in the heart of the Emilian food valley and the automotive and packaging industrial districts, the airport has a catchment area of about 11 million inhabitants and around 47,000 companies, with a strong propensity to exports and internationalisation and with commercial expansion policies to Eastern Europe and Asia.

As for airport infrastructure, the airport has among its strategic objectives in the next few years an important development plan that mainly concerns the expansion of the terminal, particularly in the gate area. The company's aim is to make Bologna Airport one of the most modern and functional in Italy, an important gateway to the city and region.
