Item 4. Summary of Material Change

International StarTeck Industries Ltd. (the "Company") is pleased to announce that it has now received financing and insurance approval from the Export Development Corporation, along with an Irrevocable Letter of Credit endorsed through the Bank of America to export prefabricated housing to a company located in Japan. StarTeck has also provided an exclusive distribution policy to its Japanese customer for this exclusive Japanese product. The initial contract is for the delivery of a minimum of 50 manufactured homes to Japan over the next twelve months. The total value of the contract exceeds \$1.7 million. The first delivery will be shipped from the Saskatoon manufacturing facility to Japan by the end of December 2000.

Item 5. Full Description of Material Change

StarTeck also reports that it is finalizing a Japanese distribution agreement to export and market its variety of specialty Wood Products (www.topqualityhomes.com/products) to the same company located in Japan. These Wood Products include the following: Bar Stool, Coffee Table, End Table, Twin Size Bed, Double Size Bed, Queen Size Bed, King Size Bed, Bunk Bed, Picnic Table, Porch Swing with Frame, Garden Bench, Gates, Dowel Style Constructed Railings, Mortice & Tenon Style Constructed Railings Stair Rails (Picket Diameters: 1.5" - 2.5", Rail Diameters: 3.5" - 4", Post Diameters: 4.5" - 6").

Manufacturing operations at the Saskatoon, Saskatchewan facility have been operating successfully since the Company acquired Prairie Manufactured Homes Inc. in June 2000. Management's continued objective is to reduce operating and inventory costs and to increase manufacturing efficiency at all levels of the manufacturing process. These cost savings will in turn be passed along to StarTeck's customers providing top quality service and excellent prices.
