**RE: Bombardier Inc.
 Report of Voting Results pursuant to Section 11.3 of National Instrument 51-102 –
 Continuous Disclosure Obligations (NI 51-102)**

Following the annual meeting of shareholders of Bombardier Inc. (the **Corporation**) held on June 18, 2020 (the **Meeting**), and in accordance with section 11.3 of NI 51-102, we hereby advise you of the following voting results obtained at the Meeting.

<u>Item Voted Upon</u>	<u>Voting Result</u>
1. Election of the directors of the Corporation:	• The nominees proposed by management were elected by a majority of the votes cast by shareholders on a vote by electronic ballot. Proxies were received and ballots were cast on this matter as indicated in Schedule "A" attached hereto.
2. Appointment of Ernst & Young LLP, chartered professional accountants, as the independent auditors of the Corporation and authorization of the directors of the Corporation to fix their remuneration:	• Ernst & Young LLP were appointed as the Corporation's independent auditors and the directors were authorized to determine their remuneration by a majority of the votes cast by shareholders on a vote by electronic ballot. 97.97% of the proxies received and ballots cast on this matter, representing a total number of 3,347,461,796 votes, were voted FOR the appointment and 2.03% of the votes, representing a total number of 69,326,692 votes, were WITHHELD.
3. Adoption of a non-binding advisory resolution (the full text of which is reproduced on page 15 of the Management Proxy Circular) on the Corporation's approach to executive compensation:	• The non-binding advisory resolution on the Corporation's approach to executive compensation was approved by a majority of the votes cast by shareholders on a vote by electronic ballot. 94.52% of the proxies received and ballots cast on this matter, representing a total number of 3,108,057,165 votes, were voted FOR the approval and 5.48%, representing a total number of 180,028,121 votes, were voted AGAINST.
