The shareholders approved the proposed plan of arrangement at the special shareholders meeting held on August 4, 2000. The acquisition of Alpine by Weatherford is subject to Alberta court approval which is expected to be obtained on August 9, 2000 and the transaction is expected to become effective shortly thereafter.

5. Full Description Of Material Change:

The shareholders approved the proposed plan of arrangement at the special shareholders meeting held on August 4, 2000. The acquisition of Alpine by Weatherford is subject to Alberta court approval which is expected to be obtained on August 9, 2000 and the transaction is expected to become effective shortly thereafter.

Under the plan of arrangement all Alpine common shareholders will receive \$Cdn 2.50 per share payable by the issuance of exchangeable shares in a Canadian subsidiary of Weatherford. Each exchangeable share will entitle the holder to one Weatherford share. For the purposes of the transaction, the value of Weatherford shares will be determined based on the average Weatherford closing price for the 10 days prior to the close of the acquisition of Alpine.
