3. News Release

A news release was issued on June 28, 2011 through Filing Services Canada and subsequently filed on SEDAR.

4. Summary of Material Change

The Company has completed a private placement ("**Private Placement**") of 348,837 units (each a "**Unit**") at a price of \$8.60 per Unit for aggregate gross proceeds of \$2,999,998.20. Each Unit is comprised of one common share of the Company, issued as a flow-through share ("**Flow-Through Share**") and one-half of one common share purchase warrant, with each whole common share purchase warrant ("**Warrant**"), exercisable at \$8.60 per share. The Flow-Through Shares and Warrants are both subject to a four-month hold period.

5. Full Description of Material Change

The first tranche (the "**First Tranche**") of the Private Placement closed on August 5, 2011, with the issuance of 237,923 Units at a price of \$8.60 per Unit for aggregate gross proceeds of \$2,046,137.80. Each Unit is comprised of one common share of the Company, issued as a Flow-Through Share and one-half of a Warrant, exercisable at \$8.60 per share until February 5, 2013.

The second tranche (the "**Second Tranche**") of the Private Placement closed on August 18, 2011, with the issuance of 110,914 Units at a price of \$8.60 per Unit for aggregate gross proceeds of \$953,860.40. Each Unit is comprised of one common share of the Company, issued as a Flow-Through Share and one-half of a Warrant, exercisable at \$8.60 per share until February 18, 2013.

The aggregate amount of the Private Placement, including the First Tranche and the Second Tranche, was 348,837 Units at a price of \$8.60 per Unit for total aggregate gross proceeds of \$2,999,998.20. The Flow-Through Shares and Warrants are both subject to a four-month hold period.

Proceeds from the sale of these Units will be used for exploration on the Company's Comtois Gold Project and the associated land area.
