3. **Press Release**

A press release reporting the material change was issued on March 11, 2004.

4. **Summary of Material Change**

Canadian Superior announced it had encountered gas pay in the El Paso Velvet Exploration Partnership (“El Paso”) / Canadian Superior Mariner I-85 well, and that El Paso, the operator of the well had determined not to proceed with testing.

5. **Full Description of Material Change**

Canadian Superior’s El Paso/Canadian Superior Mariner I-85 well encountered gas pay in multiple zones. The gas levels measured while drilling support the presence of a gas bearing reservoir and this was subsequently confirmed through evaluation of data obtained by wireline logs.

El Paso, the operator of the Mariner I-85 well determined not to conduct flow testing of the well or further completion operations.

The Mariner I-85 well is in the process of being abandoned. El Paso, as operator, presented a Well Termination Record to the Canada – Nova Scotia Offshore Petroleum Board on March 17, 2004 to abandon the well.
