Following the annual and special meeting of the shareholders of Freegold Ventures Limited (the “**Company**”) held on June 29, 2018 (the “**Meeting**”), and in accordance with section 11.3 of NI 51-102, we hereby advise you of the following voting results were obtained at the Meeting:

Item 1: Election of Directors

Each of the nine nominees set forth in the Company’s management information circular, dated May 28, 2018, (the “**Management Information Circular**”) was elected as a director of the Company unanimously by a show of hands. If a ballot had been taken, based on the proxies received by the Company, the voting results for the election of directors would have been as follows:

The resolution to re-approve all unallocated stock options, rights and other entitlements under the Company's Stock Option Plan was approved on a vote conducted by ballot, with 70.28% of the votes in favour and 29.72% against."
