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Activity Update

Vancouver, BC, April 6, 1999 – IGN Internet Global Network Inc. (NASDAQ OTC BB – IGNIF; VSE – IGN) has experienced no material changes in the operations of the Company that would account for the recent market activity and increase in stock price of the Company's common shares.

As previously announced, IGN intends to license its Internet gaming software, Casinos of the World (www.casinosoftheworld.com) and its financial transaction-processing system, INTERFI (www.interfi.com), to third-parties for license fees and a royalty on overall wagers and transactions-processed. The Company continues to receive numerous inquiries, numbering in excess of one dozen separate inquiries, from around the world to license its award-winning gaming software.

IGN's Casinos of the World (www.casinosoftheworld.com) features a full complement of popular casino games, including blackjack, video poker, roulette, video keno and various slot games, including single-line slots and the only eight-line slots on the Internet. Casinos of the World also features large progressive jackpots. Casinos of the World's gaming software has won numerous industry awards, including The Gambling Registry's 'Golden Seal Award', a '5 Aces award', and Game Royal's highest honor, its '5 Cards award'.

IGN's competitors within the growing Internet gaming market include Cryptologic Inc. (TSE: CRY), IGN Communications International Inc. (OTC BB: SNMM), GIC Global Entertainment Corp. (OTC BB: GGNC), GLC Limited (NASDAQ: GLCCF), Atlantic International Entertainment Ltd. (OTC BB: AIEE), Cybergames Inc. (OTC BB: CYGA) and Global Games Corp. (OTC BB: GLOW).

The potential of the Internet continues to increase each week. With only 25% of US households having access to the Internet, this figure, according to research firm Jupiter Communications, is expected to increase to 55% in four more years. Forrester Research recently estimated that worldwide Internet commerce could reach as high as \$3.2 trillion in 2003. The 1998 Casino & Gaming Business Market Research Handbook predicts that the Internet gaming market could reach US \$100 billion to US \$200 billion in annual revenues by 2005.
