TNR ANNOUNCES 77.5 FT. OF 1.9 G/T GOLD AT WINCHESTER ZONE, SHOTGUN PROJECT

TNR Gold Corp. ("TNR") is pleased to announce its first results from Phase I of its 2006 Shotgun Drill Program. Phase I consisted of approximately 3976.5 feet of diamond-drilling over ten drill-holes testing anomalies at Winchester (1475.5 feet) and extensions to the Shotgun Ridge Zones (2501 feet) of the property. Analytical results for subsequent holes will be released as they are received by TNR. Assays were completed by BSI Inspectorate located in Reno, Nevada, with the sample preparation done by Alaska Assay Laboratories, located in Fairbanks Alaska.

Hole 06-45 is located in the Project's new Winchester Zone, where a 2005 drill program identified felsic intrusives containing significant gold values. The Winchester Zone is the southern-most target of the Shotgun Project, approximately 18km south of the main Shotgun Ridge Zone. Hole 06-45 was drilled from the same pad as hole 06-44 at an azimuth of 250° and dip of 50°. The hole is a continuation of the section constructed with 05-31, 05-32 and 06-44 and was designed to help determine the attitude and extent of sills (or dykes) intersected in previous holes. Hole 06-44 intersected the gold-bearing intrusive 100 metres west of where a similar intrusion was intersected in 05-32 from the 2005 drill program.

Mr. Gary Schellenberg, President of TNR, notes, "We are encouraged by the initial drill results, which indicate that the felsic sills continue to return significant gold values. The geochemical gold anomaly is continuous over more than 1-kilometre strike length on the Winchester Zone. TNR has encountered gold whenever we have drilled through this anomaly."

These drill results help demonstrate the size and continuity of the Winchester Zone, an intrusion-associated gold system with a strong As-Bi-Mo-Sb-W geochemical signature. Phase I drill-holes at Winchester are step-out holes

designed to test surface geochemical anomalies that reflect possible subsurface mineralization. Phase I drilling at Shotgun Ridge has tested extensions to the NE and NW zones of that property and at depth. The Shotgun Project is located in the Kuskokwim Gold Belt Alaska which hosts the multi million ounce Donlin Creek intrusive related gold deposit located 110 miles to the north.
