Issued in West Vancouver, B.C. on September 21, 2010 under Section 85 (1) of the Act and disseminated through the facilities of Market News and Stockwatch.

4 Summary of Material Change

The Company commenced a drill program on its Marshall Lake Property.

5 Full Description of Material Change

The Company announced that it has commenced a drill program of up to 3,000 metres on its optioned Marshall Lake Property to test 3 copper-gold-silver zones on the west side of the Property. These 3 zones are a part of twelve copper, gold and silver zones which occur to the west side of this 10 by 12 km Property. As well, at least 3 other zones occur on the eastern portion of the Property containing zinc, copper and silver and further core drilling is presently being considered for a possible winter drill program.

By agreement dated July 6, 2010, Rainy Mountain Royalty Corp., formerly East West Resource Corporation ("Rainy Mountain") and Marshall Lake Mining PLC ("MLM") granted White Tiger the option to acquire up to a 50% joint venture interest in the Marshall Lake Property and project. The Marshall Lake Property is located 30 km west of Nakina, Ontario and access is by all weather gravel road from Hwy 11 and the main CNR rail line is within 22 km to the south of the Property.

The present drill program is designed to further test a new high grade discovery called "North Gazooma", as interpreted from an IP survey conducted by Rainy Mountain in 2007 and confirmed by drill holes GAZN 07-02 and 08-06:

The purpose of the present drill program is to extend the North Gazooma zone to depth and along strike. The new zone appears to be linked to the Lease copper zone 250 metres to the southwest. The second zone to be tested is the "Gazooma" (which was trenched and core drill tested and reported by Rainy Mountain in 2006 to 2008). The Gazooma zone is 600 metres to the south of the North Gazooma zone and is also 600 metres west of the Teck Hill zone where an original surface discovery was made by Walter Baker in 1954. A deep VTEM anomaly occurs at the Gazooma zone which suggests that the known sulphides may extend to depths of 250 to 300 metres. In 2006, two core drill holes were reported by Rainy Mountain near surface (drill holes GAZ 06-01 and 06-02) and intersected 1.18 % copper over a significant width of 27.9 metres and 2.05 % copper over 26.9 metres, respectively, with important gold and silver values (see Rainy Mountain's website www.rmroyalty.com for details). Within the Marshall Lake Property, the Teck Hill zone is also being considered for future core drilling in an effort to extend results from Rainy Mountain's previous drill hole TK 08-09, which intersected 0.84 % copper over 50.5 metres on the down dip of the historical Teck Hill showing.

By way of background, the Marshall Lake Property camp covers an area of approximately 120 square km and was assembled by Rainy Mountain from its own staking and from claims and leases acquired from NWT Copper Mines Ltd. and Teck Resources. The western portion of the Property contains most of the known copper zones (such as the new North Gazooma, Lease, Jewel Box, Gazooma, Teck Hill, Tala, Cherry Hill G and Cherry Hill D zones). Further drill programs are being planned in an effort to build a mineral resource within each of these potential zones.
