SENCO ANNOUNCES EXPANSION IN THE UNITED KINGDOM

VANCOUVER – Senco Sensors Inc. is pleased to announce that the Company is working with Thomas Glover and Company to form a distribution agreement for the United Kingdom.

Thomas Glover and Company is a UK fire safety and alarm company with a 100 year history and an established brand name within the industry. Thomas Glover is wholly owned by Chubb Fire who is the UK's biggest fire and security organization with a turnover in excess of £400M. Chubb Fire has unequalled industry knowledge and resources and has pioneered many of today's fire safety advances.

Senco is working with Thomas Glover to develop a 12V Carbon Monoxide (CO) alarm for the security industry. This adaptation will allow Senco's superior patented technology to be hardwired into buildings and linked to security alarms and monitoring systems. "The 12V unit is a strategic product for Thomas Glover which will enable them to offer a complete package of products to their customers." Said Kevin Stockwell, Senco's UK Managing Director. "There is a definite feeling amongst the trade that 12V CO alarms will be a large growth market within security systems. At present there are very few alarms to choose from. I believe we have the right product at the right time."

Senco is currently working towards BSI (British Standards Institute) certification for its Model One battery operated CO alarm. This CO alarm will play a strong compliment to the 12V unit for Thomas Glover allowing them to offer varied products for the UK's CO sensing needs. Denis Stewart, President of Senco, is currently facilitating the transition of manufacturing from Mexico to China and will be working on BSI certification of the China facility.

Thomas Glover has already planned out its promotional schedule for the fall with a strong push for Senco products. Road shows have been planned throughout the UK from London to Belfast. The 12V unit will be introduced via a large security show with an expected attendance of 40,000 people and will be launched through a number of trade journals with a reader reply service. Sales and marketing companies have been retained to present to housing councils through the UK. With over 2,300 housing associations and 463 councils this could prove to be a significant market. Thomas Glover plans to market via selected journals and an intensive mailing campaign directed at Housing Managers/Directors and Environmental Managers.

Senco Sensors Inc. is pleased to be associated with Thomas Glover and to be working with such a well respected company to expand its market into the United Kingdom; one of the fastest growing markets for CO alarms.
