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SHOSHONI ANNOUNCES PRIVATE PLACEMENT TO EXISTING SHAREHOLDERS and OTHER INVESTORS

Vancouver, BC, April 22, 2016 – Shoshoni Gold Inc. (SHJ:TSXV) (the “Company” or “Shoshoni”) is pleased to announce a non-brokered private placement offering for total gross proceeds of up to \$500,000.

Pursuant to the offering, the company will issue a total of up to 100 million common shares at a price of \$0.005 per common share. The Company has set June 30, 2016 as the date to seek shareholder approval of a consolidation on a minimum of 10 old shares for one new share basis. The exact ratio will be subject to shareholder approval and the post-consolidated issuer meeting board-lot distribution requirements.

The Company plans to seek a discretionary waiver from the five-cent minimum pricing requirement by the TSX Venture Exchange (“TSXV”) pursuant to the TSX-V bulletin dated April 7, 2014. There is no assurance that the TSXV will approve this financing. A finder's fee may be paid by the company in connection with the offering in accordance with the policies of the TSX-V.

The offering is open, subject to certain limitations discussed as follows, to existing shareholders of the company who, at the close of business on April 21, 2016, held common shares of the company (and who continue to hold common shares of the company at the time of closing of the offering), pursuant to the prospectus exemption set out in Multilateral CSA Notice 45-313 and the various corresponding blanket orders and rules of participating jurisdictions (the existing shareholder exemption is not available in Ontario or Newfoundland and Labrador). The total acquisition cost to a subscriber under the existing shareholder exemption cannot exceed \$15,000 unless that subscriber has obtained advice from a registered investment dealer regarding the suitability of the investment. There is a minimum subscription amount of \$1,000. Any existing shareholder interested in participating in the offering should contact the company.

If subscriptions received for the offering based on all available exemptions exceed the maximum offering amount of \$500,000, subscriptions will be accepted at the discretion of the company, such that it is possible that a subscription received from a shareholder may not be accepted by the company if the offering is oversubscribed. In accordance with the existing shareholder exemption, the company confirms there is no material fact or material change related to the company which has not been generally disclosed.

In addition to using the existing shareholder exemption, the offering will also be conducted pursuant to other available prospectus exemptions, including sales to accredited investors, as well as family members, close friends and business associates of directors and officers of the company.

Shoshoni intends to use the proceeds of the offering for maintaining and advancing its Kirkland's Creek gold exploration project, retiring existing indebtedness and for continuing general corporate and working capital purposes. A breakdown of the intended use of proceeds for the ensuing 12-month period is shown in the attached table.

Although the company intends to use the proceeds of the offering as described above, the actual allocation of net proceeds may vary from the uses set forth above, depending on future operations or unforeseen events or opportunities. If the offering is not fully subscribed, the company will apply the proceeds of the offering to the above uses in priority, and in such proportions as the board of directors and management of the company determine in the best interests of the company.

The common shares issued to subscribers resident in Canada in the offering will be subject to a statutory four-month hold period. The offering is subject to certain closing conditions, including, but not limited to, the receipt of applicable regulatory approvals including approval of the TSX-V and the completion of required regulatory filings with the TSX-V.

Shoshoni Gold Ltd. is focused on acquiring, exploring and developing gold resources to meet the world's growing demand. The Company maintains its Kirkland's Creek, Yukon project in good standing.

Shoshoni has 32,061,504 shares issued and outstanding and trades on the TSX Venture Exchange under symbol: SHJ.
