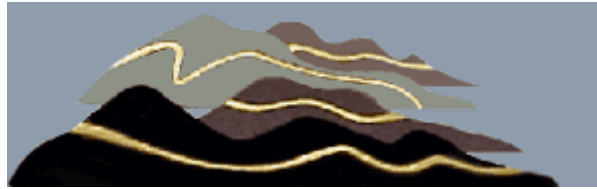

**News Release: ADROIT INTERSECTS 10 METRES OF MASSIVE SULPHIDES
ON THE SIMON COPPER PROPERTY**

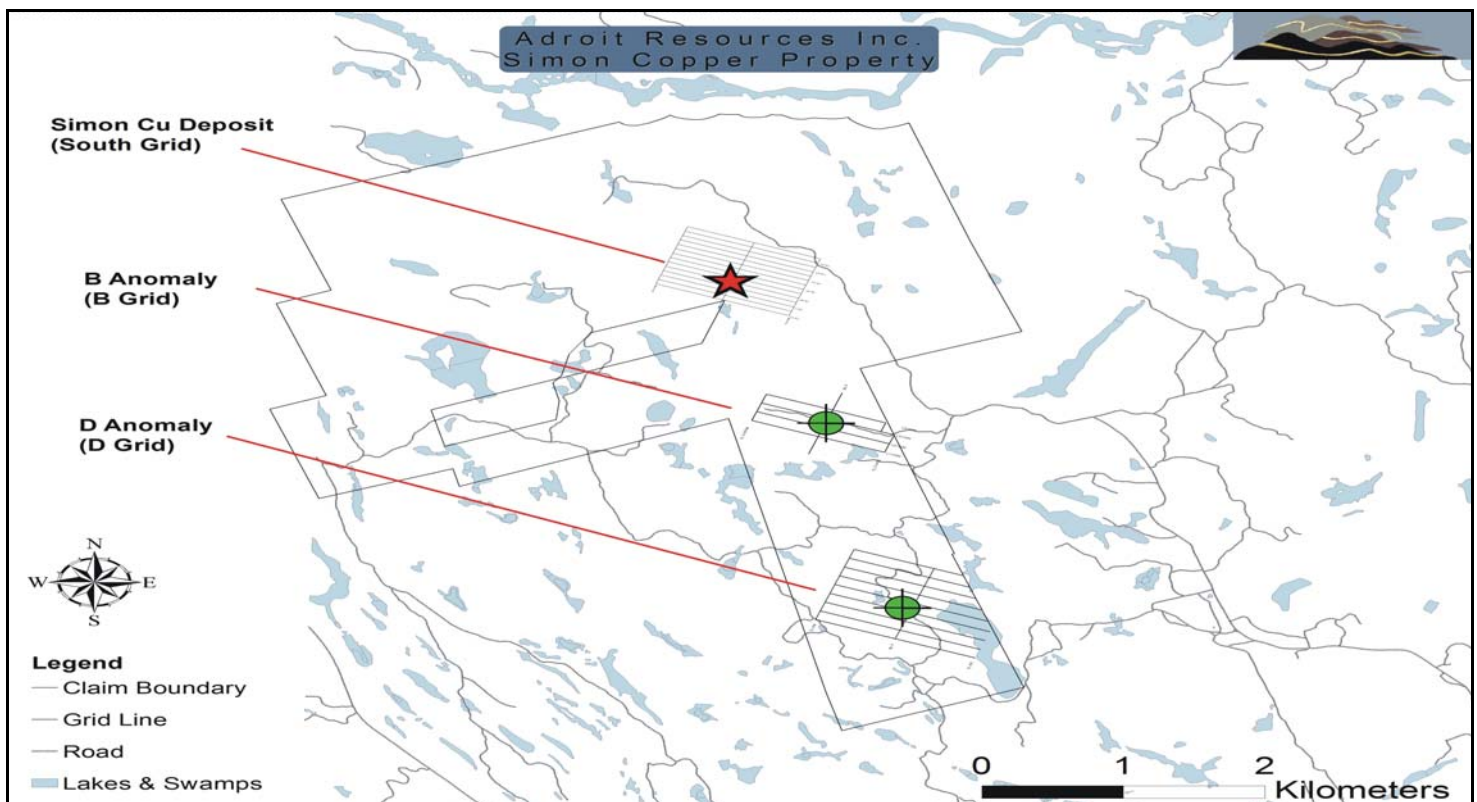

Management is pleased to provide the following update on a 19 hole, 3,029 metre diamond drilling program completed on its wholly owned Simon Copper Property, near Bankcroft, Ontario.

On the newly discovered B Zone, 5 holes, on 50 metre spacings, totaling 615 metres, were completed. All 5 holes intersected semi-massive to massive sulphides. The most impressive intersection was diamond drill hole B-04, which intersected 10.21 metres of massive sulphides just below the 100 metre level. The sulphide mineralogy consisted mostly of pyrrhotite and pyrite, with lesser amounts of chalcopyrite. Assay results are pending.

On the South Zone, 15 holes were completed totaling 2,414.34 metres. All of the holes tested the continuity of the South Zone. The South Zone has a historical low grade copper resource that does not comply with NI 43-101. Assay results from the current program are pending.

Down the hole geophysical surveys will be completed on the South Zone prior to planning the next drill program, as well as a TD-EM survey on the D Anomaly. The diamond drill will be moved this week to the Argentia Ridge Property to drill a minimum 1,000 metres testing airborne and ground geophysical anomalies.



The Simon Copper Property consists of 12 contiguous claims (92 units) covering 1,472 hectares in Denbigh and Lyndoch townships, Ontario,

All samples are currently being analyzed by Accurassay Laboratories in Thunder Bay, Ontario. The drill program was supervised by Joerg Kleinboeck, P.Geo, Adroit's Ontario Project Manager. Joerg Kleinboeck is the Company's Qualified Person for its Temagami projects under National Instrument 43-101 and has reviewed and approved the scientific and technical content of this news release.

Adroit Resources is a mineral exploration company that is currently exploring for Gold and Antimony in Central Italy and diamonds, precious and base metals in the Temagami and Bancroft areas of Ontario, Canada. In addition, Adroit is also seeking new precious and base metal projects to add to its expanding portfolio. The Company's issued and outstanding share capital is 28,279,535 common shares.
