ITEM 4 **SUMMARY OF MATERIAL CHANGE**

The Company is pleased to announce that management has made several visits to the Four Corners Uranium region in the United States, and has met with a number of key people involved in the uranium sector. Management continues to identify and investigate key uranium projects located in the states of Colorado, Utah and New Mexico, with a focus on acquisitions with historical exploration or operations. In addition to this acquisition strategy, company personnel have met with strategic exploration groups in the region for the purpose of the commencement of permitting and drill programs on Company projects.

The Company is also pleased to announce that applications have been submitted for the initiation of a preliminary drill program on the Eula Belle and King properties. These properties contain or are in close proximity to former producing uranium mines.

The Company is also pleased to it has received TSX Venture Exchange approval for the recently announced agreements covering the King group of claims (250 claims) and the Eula Belle group of claims (53 claims) all situated in Colorado. The Company has issued 200,000 common shares in its capital in accordance with the terms of the agreements which are subject to a hold period and may not be traded in Canada until February 18, 2007 except as permitted by applicable Canadian securities laws and the TSX Venture Exchange.
