On January 17, 2007, the Issuer announced an update on its eight well program planned for completion before breakup 2007, that its complete team was in place in Argentina, that it had closed the \$1,001,000 private placement announced on November 16, 2006, and that an additional private placement in excess of \$2,000,000 had been announced on January 4, 2007, which the Issuer expected to close shortly.

On January 17, 2007, the Issuer announced that it had drilled six wells of the 8 well program planned for completion before breakup 2007, and that of these wells, five were on production and one was awaiting completion. The Issuer also announced that at least 3 of the wells had two zones with capability of production, with one of these wells producing from two zones as a test.

The Issuer also announced that its complete team was in place in Argentina (regarding the proposed acquisition disclosed in the Issuer's November 1, 2006 News Release).

The Issuer also confirmed that it had closed the \$1,001,000 private placement announced on November 16, 2006 (see the Issuer's December 20, 2006 News Release), with a further private placement in excess of \$2,000,000 having been announced on January 4, 2007, which the Issuer announced it expected to close shortly.

The Issuer also announced that, following the closing of the second private placement, it would be positioned with no debt, a competent staff of professionals and substantial funds in hand augmented by a good cash-flow.
