Senternet's subsidiary Linux Corp. receives acceptance of NetLinux Takeover Bid

TORONTO, ONTARIO--On November 24, 1999, Senternet Technologies Inc. ("Senternet") announced that it acquired 100% of the issued and outstanding common shares of Linux Corp. ("Linux").

The directors of NetLinux Corp. ("NetLinux") have delivered a Directors' Circular accepting Linux's takeover bid.

Senternet will dividend 50% (2,189,665) of the common shares of Linux it acquired to the shareholders of record of Senternet as of the close of business on Wednesday, November 24, 1999.

NetLinux is a start-up software development company in the rapidly expanding Linux-based PC field.

Linux Corp. will become an aggressive marketer of Linux-based products including business software and operating systems to the server-enterprise business that wishes to bring their catalogues on-line and realize the profit potential of the Internet.
