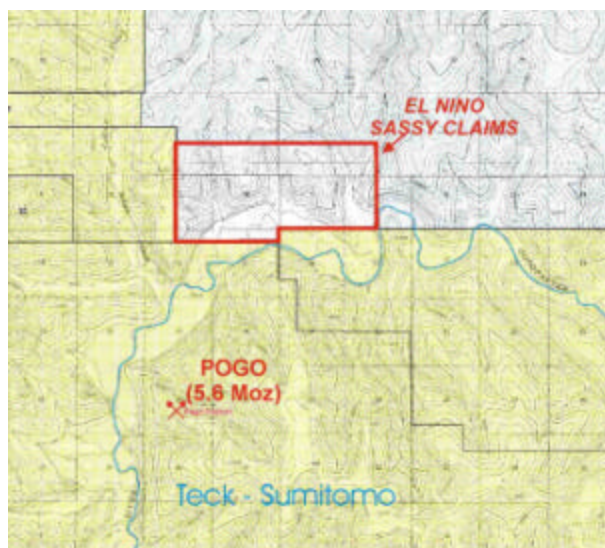
EL NINO VENTURES INC. ACQUIRES SASSY GOLD PROJECT IN THE POGO AREA, ALASKA

El Nino Ventures Inc. (El Nino) is pleased to announce that it has recently acquired 66 State of Alaska mining claims covering 2,640 acres on the Sassy gold property in Interior Alaska's Tintina Gold Belt.

Located adjacent to Teck/Sumitomo's 5.6 million ounce Pogo gold deposit in the Goodpaster Mining District, the Sassy project has potential for Pogo style or Fort Knox style mineralization. Some aspects of the structural setting at the Pogo deposit resemble the structural setting within the Sassy Claims, in particular the presence of both northeast trending and north trending kinematic faults on or near the claims.

El Nino's independent geological consultants have recommended a Phase 1 exploration program consisting of detailed stream sediment sampling, grid-based power auger soil sampling and geologic mapping and rock sampling.

Under the terms of the lease purchase option agreement with Anglo Alaska Gold Corp. (Vendor), El Nino must expend US\$80,000 on the property over the first 3 years of the lease, make cash payments of US\$40,000 during the same period and issue Anglo Alaska Gold up to 200,000 shares of El Nino common stock if the property advances through two stages of work. El Nino can acquire 100% interest in the property for US\$500,000 subject to a 3% NSR retained by the Vendor. El Nino can acquire one third of the retained NSR for an additional US\$1,000,000.
