Item 5. Full Description of Material Change

The Issuer has appointed Ms. Joan Gu to its Board of Directors.

Ms. Gu graduated from the University of Tokyo in 1984 with a Bachelor of Arts. In 1991, she founded Golion International Investment Ltd., a private company involved in investment holdings and lending. During this time, Ms. Gu was also involved in seafood, foodstuff and textile trading with Japan, China, Hong Kong and Taiwan.

In 1994, Ms. Gu was instrumental in the development of a Sino-foreign joint venture with the China's State Engineering Technology Research Centre of Power Plant Combustion. This joint venture involved investment in a fiberglass factory located in China. Ms. Gu has also been involved in real estate investments in Taiyuan, Sanxi Province and has made total investments in China of over US\$11 million.

In 1995, Ms. Gu was appointed an honorary citizen of Shenyang City, Liaoning Province, China. As well, Toronto mayor Mel Lastman retained her to help the city of

North York establish sister city relationships with three Chinese cities: Shenyang, Harbin City and Xiamen.

Ms. Gu has organized and chaired multiple investment and technology related conferences in China and Canada. Most recently, in November 2001, she organized the China Liaoning Technology & Products Exhibition in Vancouver in coordination with the China's Liaoning Provincial government and with the cooperation of the Liaoning Province's Science & Technology Commission.

Ms. Gu will aid the Issuer in reviewing and negotiating various business opportunities in the technology and industrial sectors.
