The kiosk and wireless strategy offers an increasing array of benefits with practical real world applications that extend to secure e-commerce transactions, electronic couponing, bill payment, transmitting marketing and promotional messages, and instant e-mail access via digital devices.

Specifically the Surfnet kiosk now acts as a "base station" to power wireless applications in order to:

- Dispense information on a metered access, subscription or per transaction basis
- Provide retailers, financial institutions and other commercial or government organizations the ability to provide multi-purpose access and coverage to “always available” digital content increasing the opportunity for multiple transactions.

The wireless protocol most conducive to a retail or commercial environment and that is attracting the most interest with consumers is 802.11b or Wi-Fi, mainly because of its low barriers to entry (ie. cost, installation, maintenance, etc...). Recent difficulties caused by the economic slowdown as well as the enormous third-generation, or 3G, wireless license fees have resulted in Wi-Fi's increased success in deploying networks and acquiring wireless customers over 3G. Other protocols that are receiving interest are infrared and Bluetooth.
