



Wayland Addresses Transaction with ICC International Cannabis Corp.

TORONTO, May 02, 2019 -- Wayland Group (CSE:WAYL) (FRANKFURT: 75M) (OTCQB:MRRCF) ("Wayland" or the "Company") confirms that any failure-to-file cease trade order ("FFCTO") derived from the Company's delay in annual filings will not materially affect the Company's sale of a 49.9% interest in its international asset and license portfolio to ICC International Cannabis Corp (the "Transaction").

Wayland is of the opinion that the Company's delay in annual filings will not impede closing timeline of the Transaction.

The Company also has production operations in Dresden, Saxony, Germany, Regensburg, Switzerland and, Alessandria, Piedmont, Italy. Wayland will continue to pursue new opportunities globally, including the consummation of its previously announced transactions in the United Kingdom, Australia, Colombia, and Argentina, in its effort to enhance lives through cannabis.
