Item 3 **News Release**

The news release dated February 23, 2005 was issued in Vancouver, B.C. and disseminated through Canada Stock Watch.

Item 4 **Summary of Material Change**

The Company reported it would make a cash payment of \$50,000 on August 31, 2005, issue 300,000 shares and spend \$3,000,000 over the next 36 months to acquire a 50% interest in the Belleterre claim block owned by J.A.G. Mines Ltd. The property is composed of 77 claims totalling 2375 acres upon which the mothballed Aubelle Mine is located.

Item 5 **Full Description of Material Change**

The Company reported it will make a cash payment of \$50,000 on August 31, 2005, and issue 100,000 shares upon approval of the Company's re-list application. In addition, it will issue 100,000 shares on each of the first and second anniversary of the application approval.

Under terms of the agreement, the company must also incur a total of \$3,000,000 in expenditures on the property over 3 years with a minimum commitment of \$500,000 in the first year.

The property is part of the "Belleterre-Angliers" volcano-sedimentary Greenstone Belt. It is located in what is known as the Temiscaming region of Quebec, between the Grenville front to the south, and the Abitibi Greenstone Belt to the north. Structural boundaries and litho logical differences divide the belt in three distinct groups with the "Baby Group" in the west, the "Lac des Bois Group" in the south, and the "Belleterre Group" in the east. More than fifteen unexplored, gold-bearing veins are reported on the property and lie in the strike zone, which include the Belleterre Mine, Mentor/ Lake Expanse/Vantex deposit. Proven reserves are listed at 353,000 tonnes at 4.4 g/mt (50,000 oz Au).

This area will be the focus of a diamond drilling program that will be carried out in 2005 the details of which will be formalized in the a Geological Survey that has just begun and will be completed in the next ninety days.
