3. News Release

A news release was issued on January 9, 2007 through the facilities of CCNMatthews and was filed with regulatory authorities in Canada.

4. Summary of Material Change

On January 9, 2007 the Company announced the completion of an updated resource estimate on the Company's Kinsevere copper mine located in the Katanga Province of the Democratic Republic of the Congo ("DRC").

5. Full Description of Material Change

The Company has announced the completion of an updated resource estimate on the Company's Kinsevere copper mine project located in the Katanga Province of the DRC. This resource update is based on assay results from a drilling program comprised of 95 air core holes, 102 RC holes and 23 diamond holes, for a total of 17,220 metres drilled. This program, which targeted the Tshifufia orebody was completed in October, 2006, and has resulted in an increase in all resource categories, with a 307% increase in contained copper metal for the Measured and Indicated resource categories, and a 422% increase for the Inferred resource category, compared to the 2005 year end estimate.

The table below summarises the latest mineral resource estimate, as at October 30, 2006.

The Kinsevere drill program was supervised on-site by Roger Tyler, Anvil's Exploration Manager in the DRC. The Mineral Resource estimate and an independent technical report were prepared under the supervision of Gerry Fahey, of FinOre Pty Ltd. Both Roger Tyler and Gerry Fahey are Qualified Persons, in accordance with National Instrument 43-101.

All samples were prepared for assay and analysed at the ALS Chemex laboratory in Johannesburg, and standard QA/QC checks were applied throughout the drill program, including the submission of certified reference materials, duplicate samples and blanks. Routine QA/QC checks were applied throughout the drill program, including the submission of certified reference materials, duplicate samples and blanks.
