



Altair Appoints Moe Dillon to its Board Of Directors

Young, Chairman and CEO, is pleased to announce the appointment of Mr. Moe Dillon to the Board of Directors of Altair Resources Inc. Mr. Dillon brings a vast amount of experience in local and international capital and public markets, having worked on numerous mergers and acquisitions, raising capital and adding shareholder value. Mr. Dillon began his career as a commodities trader for a well-known Wall Street firm, managing their Asian operations out of Singapore in the 1970's. He moved to Canada in 1989 and made a series of investments in the commodities and resource space, bringing in co-investors from Asia. Later, he became an advisor to Ivanhoe Mines Ltd. More recently, he also served as a Director of ZoomAway Travel Inc. (formerly, Multivision Communications Corp.).

Altair also announces that Mr. John Booth will step down from the Board of Directors and join the Company's Advisory Board and continue in a role of assisting the Company with its financings and other business objectives.
