Item 5.1	<u>Full Description of Material Change</u> Sego reports that it will start an 1800 metre percussion drill program on Monday February 28, 2011. The program plan is to drill 30 holes to a depth of 60 metres each (approximately 200 feet), through the oxide (gossan) cap in the Granby Zone. This drilling will test for a supergene enrichment, the mineralization beneath the cap and to test areas to the east and west of the known zone. Sego Resources has raised \$833,816.97 since September 24, 2010 through the exercise of Warrants and Agents Options. Sego Resources Inc.'s sole project is the Miner Mountain Project, a Copper Gold Porphyry project near Princeton, B.C., 15 kilometres north of Copper Mountain Mining Corporation's former copper producer, which closed in 1996. Copper Mountain Mining Corporation is planning to restart full production in June 2011. The Miner Mountain Project is situated within the Traditional Territory of the Upper Similkameen Indian Band, with whom Sego has a Comprehensive Memorandum of Understanding.
