

28.0 STATEMENT OF QUALIFICATIONS AND SIGNATURE PAGE

I, Linda J. Caron, certify that:

1. I am an independent consulting geologist residing at 717 75th Ave (Box 2493), Grand Forks, B.C., V0H 1H0.
2. I obtained a B.A.Sc. in Geological Engineering (Honours) in the Mineral Exploration Option, from the University of British Columbia (1985) and graduated with a M.Sc. in Geology and Geophysics from the University of Calgary (1988).
3. I have practised my profession since 1987 and have worked in the mineral exploration industry since 1980. I have done extensive geological work in British Columbia, and elsewhere, as an employee of various exploration companies and as an independent consultant. My work has included a large variety of deposit styles, including but not limited to epithermal gold-silver, porphyry copper-gold, porphyry molybdenum, skarn (copper, gold), Archean greenstone belt gold, polymetallic veins, sediment-hosted gold, listwanite lode gold, transitional porphyry-epithermal, VMS (including precious metal-enriched VMS), and intrusive-related Au pyrrhotite veins. I have worked on properties at all stages of exploration, from grass-roots, to early-stage exploration, through advanced-stage exploration and active mining. Of particular relevance to the Sheslay project is my work as an independent consultant on the Galaxy alkalic porphyry copper-gold property in the Iron Mask batholith near Kamloops, British Columbia (2006-2007). This work included an assessment of extensive previous drilling on the property. Also of particular relevance to the Sheslay property, is my work (2007- 2012) as qualified person and independent consultant on the Baroyeca porphyry/epithermal property in Sonora, Mexico. During this period, work included geochemical and geophysical surveys plus significant drilling.
4. I am a member in good standing with the Association of Professional Engineers and Geoscientists of B.C. with professional engineer status.
5. I have no previous involvement in the Sheslay property. I visited the property on May 23, 2013.

I have reviewed the available data pertinent to the Sheslay property, as listed in Section 27.0 of this report, and I believe this data to be accurate. Based on my property visit and on a review of the available data, I believe this property to be of sufficient merit to justify the work programs recommended in this report.

6. I have no direct or indirect interest in the property described herein, or in Prosper Gold Corp., nor do I expect to receive any.
7. I am a Qualified Person and independent of Prosper Gold Corp. and of Firesteel Resources Ltd., as defined by National Instrument 43-101.
