iAnthus Announces Filing of Amendment and Effectiveness of Form 10 Registration Statement

Becomes Full SEC Reporting Company

NEW YORK and TORONTO, February 5, 2021 /PRNewswire/ - iAnthus Capital Holdings, Inc. ("iAnthus" or the "Company") (CSE: IAN) (OTCPK: ITHUF), which owns, operates, and partners with regulated cannabis operations across the United States, today announced that it has filed an amendment to its Form 10 Registration Statement ("Form 10"), previously filed on December 8, 2020 with the United States Securities and Exchange Commission ("SEC") to register its common stock under Section 12 of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, as amended (the "Exchange Act"), and that the Form 10, as amended, became effective as of February 5, 2021. Following the effective date, iAnthus will be subject to the reporting requirements of the Exchange Act. This means the Company will begin filing annual reports with the SEC on Form 10-K, quarterly reports on Form 10-Q, periodic reports on Form 8-K, and subject itself to additional reporting obligations related to proxies, shareholder actions and stock ownership rules. In addition, the Company is subject to U.S. GAAP reporting requirements with respect to the reports it files with the SEC.

The Form 10, as amended, provides detailed and audited information about the Company's operations, including an overview of the business strategies, risk factors and financial statements with respect to the Company. The ongoing obligation to timely file with the SEC will also help the Company's new and current investors make more informed and educated investment decisions about the Company. The Form 10, as amended, is available on Canada's System for Electronic Document Analysis and Retrieval ("SEDAR") at www.sedar.com, the SEC's website at www.sec.gov and on the Company's website.
