In addition, the Facedrive Health initiative offers ongoing management of medication refills, for users, ensuring that our customers always have the medication they need, while also ensuring appropriate social distancing protocols are utilized.

“The Facedrive Health initiative is designed to ensure that all frontline healthcare workers who need to be mobile have a reliable and efficient way of getting around. We hope that this dedicated service gives hospitals and their medical workers the flexibility to provide optimal healthcare to patients and families suffering from the COVID-19 pandemic,” said Facedrive Chief Operations Officer Suman Pushparajah. “We are grateful to all dedicated healthcare workers on the frontline of the COVID-19 pandemic, and everything they are sacrificing for their communities.
