EXPLANATORY NOTES

1. If you intend to come to the AGM please complete this admission card and bring it with you to the AGM. To comply with the UK government's 'Stay at Home' measures, shareholders will not be permitted to attend the AGM in person.
2. Only holders of Ordinary Shares, or their duly appointed representatives, are entitled to attend, speak and vote at the AGM. A member so entitled may appoint (a) proxy(ies), who need not be (a) shareholder(s), to attend, speak and vote on his/her behalf.
3. If you wish to appoint someone other than the Chairman of the AGM as your proxy, please insert his/her name in the space provided and delete 'the Chairman of the meeting, or'. A proxy need not be a shareholder of the Company, but must attend the AGM in person to represent you. To comply with the government's 'Stay at Home' measures, proxies appointed other than the Chairman of the AGM will not be permitted to attend the AGM in person.
4. A corporation which is a member can appoint one or more corporate representatives who may exercise, on its behalf, all its powers as a member provided that no more than one corporate representative exercises powers over the same share.
5. 6. The 'Vote withheld' option on the Form of Proxy is provided to enable you to abstain on the resolution. However, a vote withheld is not a vote in law and will not be counted in the calculation of the proportion of votes 'For' and 'Against' a resolution.
7. If the Form of Proxy is signed by someone else on your behalf, the original or a certified copy of the document evidencing their authority to sign must be returned with the Form of Proxy. If the shareholder is a corporation, the form must be executed under its common seal or signed by an officer, attorney or other person duly authorised by the corporation.
8. In the case of a joint holding, any holder may sign. Where more than one of the joint holders purports to appoint a proxy, only the appointment submitted by the most senior holder will be accepted. Seniority is determined by the order in which the names of the joint holders appear in the Company's register of members in respect of the joint holding (the first-named being the most senior).
9. To be entitled to attend or vote at the meeting (and for the purpose of determining the number of votes you may cast) you must be entered on the Company's Register of Members as at 6.30pm (UK time) on 22 May 2020 or, if the meeting is adjourned, you must be entered on the Company's Register of Members no later than 6.30pm (UK time) on the day being two days prior to the day of the adjourned meeting (excluding any part of a day that is not a business day). Changes to entries on the ordinary register after 6.30pm (UK time) on 22 May 2020 shall be disregarded in determining the right of any person to attend or vote at the AGM (unless the AGM is adjourned in which case the previous provisions of this Note 9 apply).
10. To be valid, the Form of Proxy must reach the Company's Registrar, Equiniti Limited, by no later than 2.00pm (UK time) on 22 May 2020 or, if the AGM is adjourned, 48 hours before the time for holding the adjourned AGM (excluding non-working days). Lodgement of a Form of Proxy does not prevent a member from attending and voting at the AGM in person. Failure to deposit, receive or deliver the appointment of a proxy in accordance with these requirements shall entitle the Company to treat such instrument as being invalid save that the directors may, in their absolute discretion, treat such an instrument as valid notwithstanding any default in complying with these requirements.
11. Electronic Proxy Appointment ('EPA') is available for this AGM. To appoint a proxy electronically, log on to the Company's Registrar's website at www.sharevote.co.uk. The Voting ID, Task ID and Shareholder Reference Number shown above will be required. Full details of the procedures are given on the website. Alternatively, if you have already registered with the Company's Registrar's online portfolio service, Shareview, you can submit your proxy by logging on to your portfolio at www.shareview.co.uk using your usual user ID and password. Once logged in simply click 'View' on the 'My Investments' page, click on the link to vote then follow the on screen instructions. EPA will not be valid if received after 2.00pm (UK time) on 22 May 2020 or, if the AGM is adjourned, 48 hours before the time for holding the adjourned AGM, and will not be accepted if found to contain a computer virus.
12. The CREST electronic proxy appointment service is available for this AGM. To use this service CREST members should transmit a CREST proxy instruction, using the procedures described in the CREST manual, so as to reach the Company's Registrar, Equiniti, (CREST participant ID RA19) by no later than 2.00pm (UK time) on 22 May 2020 or, if the AGM is adjourned, 48 hours before the time for holding the adjourned AGM (excluding non-working days).
13. Full details of the resolution to be proposed at the AGM, with explanatory notes, are set out in the Notice of AGM enclosed with this card.
14. In order to revoke a proxy instruction you will need to inform the Company by sending a signed hard copy notice clearly stating your intention to revoke your proxy appointment to the Company's Registrars, Equiniti Limited, Aspect House, Spencer Road, Lancing, West Sussex BN99 6DA, United Kingdom. In the case of a member which is a company, the revocation notice must be executed under its common seal or signed on its behalf by an officer of the company or an attorney for the company. Any power of attorney or any other authority under which the revocation notice is signed (or a duly certified copy of such power or authority) must be included with the revocation notice. The revocation notice must be received by Equiniti by 2.00pm (UK time) on 22 May 2020 or, if the AGM is adjourned, 48 hours prior to the adjourned meeting (excluding non-working days).
15. If you submit more than one valid proxy appointment in respect of the same shares, the appointment received last before the latest time for the receipt of proxies will take precedence. If the Company is unable to determine which was last delivered or received, none of them shall be treated as valid in respect of that share.
