The undersigned, a duly appointed executive officer of Menē Inc. (the “**Corporation**”), hereby certifies as an executive officer of the Corporation and not in his personal capacity, that:

1. In order to be qualified to file a prospectus in the form of a short form prospectus, the Corporation is relying on the basic qualification criteria set forth in section 2.2 of National Instrument 44-101 – *Short Form Prospectus Distributions*, namely:
 - (a) the Corporation is an electronic filer under National Instrument 13-101 – *System for Electronic Document Analysis and Retrieval (SEDAR)*;
 - (b) the Corporation is a reporting issuer in at least one jurisdiction of Canada;
 - (c) the Corporation has filed with the securities regulatory authority in each jurisdiction in which it is a reporting issuer all periodic and timely disclosure documents that it is required to have filed in that jurisdiction:
 - (i) under applicable securities legislation;
 - (ii) pursuant to an order issued by the securities regulatory authority; or
 - (iii) pursuant to an undertaking to the securities regulatory authority;
 - (d) the Corporation is relying on the exemption set forth in section 2.7(3)(b) of National Instrument 44-101 – *Short Form Prospectus Distributions*, as the TSX Venture Exchange required an “information circular” be filed as the disclosure document instead of a “filing statement” in connection with a reverse takeover and the

information circular complied with the TSX Venture Exchange Corporate Finance Manual, as amended from time to time; and

- (e) the Corporation's equity securities are listed and posted for trading on a short form eligible exchange and the Corporation is not an issuer:
 - (i) whose operations have ceased; or
 - (ii) whose principal asset is cash, cash equivalents, or its exchange listing.
- 2. All of the basic qualification criteria set forth above in paragraph 1 have been satisfied.
- 3. All of the material incorporated by reference in the preliminary short form prospectus and not previously filed is being filed with the prospectus of the Corporation dated December 10, 2018.
