

Cheelcare Receives "Compliant" Rating from Health Canada Following Routine Inspection

Markham, Ontario--(Newsfile Corp. - November 24, 2025) - Cheelcare Inc. (TSXV: CHER) ("Cheelcare" or the "Company"), a Canadian leader in assistive mobility devices, has received a "Compliant" rating from Health Canada, following a routine regulatory inspection conducted between October 22 and November 3, 2025.

The inspection was conducted at Cheelcare's new 16,000 sq. ft. manufacturing and R&D facility in Markham, which the Company began occupying this fall as part of its broader expansion strategy. The compliant rating indicates that, at the time of the inspection, Cheelcare has demonstrated that the activities it conducts comply with the Food and Drugs Act and the Medical Devices Regulations.

"Achieving a compliant rating is a strong validation of the investment we've made in our quality systems as we scale our manufacturing," said Dmitry Paltsev, Co-Founder of Cheelcare. "This inspection confirms that our operations are built on a solid regulatory foundation, which is essential as we increase the production of Companion and bring the Curio robotic wheelchair into full commercial launch. Strengthening our quality framework remains a key focus as we progress toward ISO 13485:2016 and ISO 9001:2015 certifications."

Cheelcare has updated several internal processes - including standard operating procedures and record retention practices - based on observations outlined in the final inspection report. These enhancements align with Health Canada's guidance and support the Company's commitment to delivering safe, effective, and high-quality mobility solutions.

With its newly expanded facility, Cheelcare is positioned to support increased demand, accelerate R&D efforts, and further scale production capacity for both existing and upcoming product lines.
