You are entitled to appoint a proxy or proxies, who need not be a member of the Company or the chairman, to exercise all or any of your rights to attend, ask questions and vote at a general meeting of the Company. If a member is a company, this proxy form must be executed under its common seal (or such form of execution as has the same effect) or executed on its behalf by a duly authorised officer of the Company or an attorney for the Company. Alternatively, if nominated persons do not have such a right, or do not wish to exercise it, they may have a right under such an agreement to give instructions to the person holding the shares as to the exercise of voting rights.
