1. INTRODUCTION

The purpose of this circular is to provide you with information regarding resolutions to be proposed at the Annual General Meeting to be held at 17/F, Tower C, Dongjin International Centre, East of Yaowahu Bridge, East 4th Ring Road, Chaoyang District, Beijing, PRC on Friday, 15 May 2026 at 10:30 a.m. relating to, among other things, (i) the granting of general mandates to the Directors for the issue and repurchase of the Shares; and (ii) the re-election of Directors.

LETTER FROM THE BOARD

2. PROPOSED GRANTING OF THE REPURCHASE AND ISSUANCE MANDATES

At the last annual general meeting of the Company held on 8 May 2025, general mandates were granted to the Directors to exercise the powers of the Company to repurchase Shares and to issue new Shares respectively. Such mandates will lapse at the conclusion of the Annual General Meeting.

Ordinary resolutions will be proposed at the Annual General Meeting to approve the granting of new general mandates to the Directors:

- (a) to purchase Shares on the Stock Exchange up to 10% of the total number of the Shares in issue (“**Repurchase Mandate**”) on the date of passing such resolution (i.e. up to 452,613,544 Shares on the basis that the total number of issued Shares remains unchanged on the date of the Annual General Meeting);
- (b) to allot, issue or deal with Shares up to 20% of the total number of the Shares in issue (“**Issuance Mandate**”) on the date of passing such resolution (i.e. up to 905,227,088 Shares on the basis that the total number of issued Shares remains unchanged on the date of the Annual General Meeting); and
- (c) to extend the Issuance Mandate by the total number of Shares repurchased by the Company pursuant to and in accordance with the Repurchase Mandate.

The Company had 4,526,135,442 Shares in issue as at the Latest Practicable Date. The Repurchase Mandate and the Issuance Mandate will continue in force until the conclusion of the next annual general meeting of the Company held after the Annual General Meeting or any earlier date as referred to in the proposed ordinary resolutions contained in items 4 and 5 of the notice of the Annual General Meeting as set out on pages N-1 to N-4 of this circular. With reference to the Repurchase Mandate and the Issuance Mandate, the Directors wish to state that they have no immediate plan to repurchase any Shares or issue any Shares pursuant thereto.

In accordance with the requirements of the Listing Rules, the Company is required to send to the Shareholders an explanatory statement containing all the information reasonably necessary to enable them to make an informed decision on whether to vote for or against the granting of the Repurchase Mandate. The explanatory statement as required by the Listing Rules in connection with the Repurchase Mandate is set out in Appendix I to this circular.

3. PROPOSED RE-ELECTION OF DIRECTORS

Pursuant to Bye-law 99 of the Bye-laws, at each annual general meeting one third of the Directors for the time being, or, if their number is not a multiple of three, then the number nearest to one-third but not less than one-third, shall retire from office by rotation. The Directors to retire in every year shall be those who have been longest in office since their last election but as between persons who became Directors on the same day shall (unless they otherwise agree between themselves) be determined by lot provided that every Director shall be subject to retirement at least once every three years. Mr. Peng Xitao and Ms. Liu Haoming will retire by rotation at the Annual General Meeting and, being eligible, will offer themselves for re-election.

Pursuant to Bye-law 102(B) of the Bye-laws, the Board shall have power from time to time and at any time to appoint any person as a Director either to fill a casual vacancy or as an addition to the Board. Any Director so appointed shall hold office only until the first annual general meeting of the Company after his appointment and be subject to re-election. Ms. Zhang Xiaofen, who was appointed as an independent non-executive Director with effect from 20 August 2025, shall hold office until the Annual General Meeting and, being eligible, will offer herself for re-election.

The Nomination Committee considered and assessed the suitability of the above Directors for re-election in accordance with the Nomination Policy of Directors of the Company. The Nomination Committee also took into account the structure and size of the Board as well as the various diversity aspects set out in the Board Diversity Policy of the Company. The Nomination Committee is of the view that the retiring Directors are able to continue to fulfill their roles as required and are appropriate to stand for re-election and their re-appointment would enhance the diversity of the Board. Ms. Liu Haoming and Ms. Zhang Xiaofen, members of the Nomination Committee, have abstained from voting on her own nomination when it was considered.

Pursuant to Rule 13.74 of the Listing Rules, an issuer shall disclose the details required under Rule 13.51(2) of the Listing Rules of any directors proposed to be re-elected or proposed new director in the notice or accompanying circular to its shareholders of the relevant general meeting, if such re-election or appointment is subject to shareholders' approval at that relevant general meeting. The requisite details of Mr. Peng Xiaotao, Ms. Liu Haoming and Ms. Zhang Xiaofen are set out in Appendix II to this circular. Separate resolutions will be proposed at the Annual General Meeting for re-election of each retiring Director.

4. ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING AND PROXY ARRANGEMENT

The notice of the Annual General Meeting is set out on pages N-1 to N-4 of this circular. At the Annual General Meeting, resolutions will be proposed to approve, inter alia, the granting of the Repurchase Mandate and the Issuance Mandate, extension of the Issuance Mandate by the addition thereto of the number of Shares repurchased pursuant to the Repurchase Mandate and re-election of Directors.

A form of proxy for use at the Annual General Meeting is enclosed with this circular and such form of proxy is also published on the websites of the Stock Exchange (<https://www.hkexnews.hk>) and the Company (<https://ir.crazysports.com>). To be valid, the form of proxy must be completed and signed in accordance with the instructions printed thereon and deposited, together with the power of attorney or other authority (if any) under which it is signed or a notarially certified copy of that power of attorney or authority, at the Branch Share Registrar in Hong Kong, Tricor Investor Services Limited, at 17/F, Far East Finance Centre, 16 Harcourt Road, Hong Kong, as soon as possible but in any event not less than 48 hours before the time appointed for holding the Annual General Meeting or any adjournment thereof. 5. VOTING BY POLL

Pursuant to Rule 13.39(4) of the Listing Rules, any vote of Shareholders at a general meeting must be taken by poll except where the chairman, in good faith, decides to allow a resolution which relates purely to a procedural or administrative matter to be voted on by a show of hands. The chairman of the Annual General Meeting will therefore demand voting on the resolutions set out in the notice of the Annual General Meeting be taken by way of poll.

On a poll, every Shareholder present in person (or, in the case of a Shareholder being a corporation, by its duly authorised representative) or by proxy shall have one vote for every full paid Share held. A Shareholder entitled to more than one vote is under no obligation to cast all his/her votes in the same way.

The following is an explanatory statement required by the Listing Rules to be sent to the Shareholders to enable them to make an informed decision on whether to vote for or against the ordinary resolution to be proposed at the Annual General Meeting in relation to the granting of the Repurchase Mandate.

1. REASONS FOR REPURCHASE OF SHARES

The Directors believe that the granting of the Repurchase Mandate is in the interests of the Company and the Shareholders.

Repurchases of Shares may, depending on the market conditions and funding arrangements at the time, lead to an enhancement of the net asset value per Share and/or earnings per Share. The Directors are seeking the granting of the Repurchase Mandate to give the Company the flexibility to do so if and when appropriate. The number of Shares to be repurchased on any occasion and the price and other terms upon which the same are repurchased will be decided by the Directors at the relevant time, having regard to the circumstances then pertaining.

2. SHARE CAPITAL

As at the Latest Practicable Date, the issued share capital of the Company comprised 4,526,135,442 Shares.

Subject to the passing of the ordinary resolution set out in item 4 of the notice of the Annual General Meeting in respect of the granting of the Repurchase Mandate and on the basis that the total number of Shares in issue remains unchanged on the date of the Annual General Meeting, i.e. being 4,526,135,442 Shares, the Directors would be authorised under the Repurchase Mandate to repurchase, during the period in which the Repurchase Mandate remains in force, up to 452,613,544 Shares, representing 10% of the total number of Shares in issue as at the date of the Annual General Meeting.

3. FUNDING OF REPURCHASES

In repurchasing Shares, the Company may only apply funds legally available for such purpose in accordance with its Bye-laws, the laws of Bermuda and/or any other applicable laws, as the case may be.

The Company is empowered by its Bye-laws to repurchase Shares. The laws of Bermuda provide that the amount of capital paid in connection with a share repurchase by a company may only be paid out of either the capital paid up on the relevant shares, or the funds of the company which would otherwise be available for dividend or distribution or out of the proceeds of a fresh issue of shares made for such purpose. The amount of premium payable on repurchase may only be paid out of the funds of the Company which would otherwise be available for dividend or distribution or out of the share premium account of the Company before the shares are repurchased.

4. IMPACT OF REPURCHASES

Repurchased Shares shall be treated as cancelled and the amount of the Company's issued capital shall be diminished by the nominal value of those Shares accordingly; but the purchase of Shares under this section shall not be taken as reducing the amount of the Company's authorised share capital.

There might be a material adverse impact on the working capital or gearing position of the Company in the event that the Repurchase Mandate was to be carried out in full at any time during the proposed repurchase period. However, the Directors do not intend to exercise the Repurchase Mandate to such extent as would, in the circumstances, have a material adverse effect on the working capital requirements of the Company or the gearing levels which in the opinion of the Directors are from time to time appropriate for the Company.

5. TAKEOVERS CODE

If, on the exercise of the power to repurchase Shares pursuant to the Repurchase Mandate, a Shareholder's proportionate interest in the voting rights of the Company increases, such increase will be treated as an acquisition for the purposes of the Takeovers Code. Accordingly, a Shareholder, or group of Shareholders acting in concert, could obtain or consolidate control of the Company and become obliged to make a mandatory offer in accordance with Rule 26 of the Takeovers Code for all the Shares not already owned by such Shareholder or group of Shareholders.

To the best knowledge of the Company, as at the Latest Practicable Date, Dr. Zhang Lijun, a substantial shareholder and the single largest shareholder of the Company, together with his spouse Ms. Wang Chun were interested in 1,034,563,113 Shares representing approximately 22.86% of the total number of issued Shares. In the event that the Directors exercise the proposed Repurchase Mandate in full, the aggregate shareholding of Dr. Zhang Lijun and Ms. Wang Chun would be increased to approximately 25.40% of the total number of issued Shares. The Directors are not aware of any consequences which will arise under the Takeovers Code as a result of any repurchases to be made under the Repurchase Mandate. In addition, the Directors consider that the full exercise of the Repurchase Mandate will not lead to the percentage of the Company's public float falling below 25.0% of the total number of issued Shares.

6. UNDERTAKING

None of the Directors or, to the best of their knowledge having made all reasonable enquiries, any of their respective close associates (as defined in the Listing Rules) have any present intention to sell any Shares to the Company in the event that the granting of the Repurchase Mandate is approved by the Shareholders.

The Company has not been notified by any core connected persons (as defined in the Listing Rules) of the Company that they have a present intention to sell any Shares to the Company, or that they have undertaken not to sell any Shares held by them to the Company in the event that the granting of the Repurchase Mandate is approved by the Shareholders.

The Directors confirm that neither the explanatory statement on the Repurchase Mandate nor the proposed share repurchase has unusual features. The Directors also confirm that the exercise the power of the Company to make repurchases of Shares pursuant to the Repurchase Mandate will be in accordance with the Listing Rules and the applicable laws of Bermuda.

With its outstanding product features, Lottery 365 had received many prestigious awards for its product innovation and branding in the industry. In 2015, Mr. Peng founded Crazy Sports and served as the Chief Executive Officer. He pioneered the paid sports information platform – Crazy Red Insights which focus on providing lottery users with professional analyses and information services relating to football and basketball games, and such platform has quickly become a leader in the industry.

Saved as disclosed above, Mr. Peng did not hold any other directorships in any listed public companies the securities of which are listed on any securities market in Hong Kong or overseas in the last three years or had other major appointment and qualification and does not hold any other positions with the Company or other members of the Group.

She graduated from Jiangsu College of Engineering and Technology and currently serves as the General Manager of Suzhou China-Europe Technology Transfer Co., Ltd. and Suzhou High-Tech Zone Lupu Entrepreneurship Service Co., Ltd. She is also a member of the Sports Management Professional Committee of the China Management Science Society and a member of the China Association for Science and Technology Finance. Ms. Zhang has been engaged in corporate management training and consulting for over 20 years, serving as an innovation strategy consultant for numerous well-known Chinese enterprises. She previously worked as an assistant to Professor Edison Tse, a tenured professor at Stanford University, and was a core expert in the “Disruptive Innovation” Business Thinking framework. As a member of the editorial board, she contributed to the publication of “The Art of Disruptive Innovation” and “Product Management and Reshaping”. She also managed the operation and administration of the Tsinghua University Continuous Education College’s Entrepreneur Training Program in Suzhou, focusing on the incubation of startups, technology and industrialization services for new quality productive forces such as artificial intelligence, and government project investment and implementation.
