PROPOSED SHARE CONSOLIDATION

PROPOSED SHARE CONSOLIDATION

The Board proposes to implement the Share Consolidation on the basis that every twenty (20) issued and unissued Existing Shares of HK\$0.10 each will be consolidated into one (1) Consolidated Share of HK\$2.00 each. The Share Consolidation is conditional upon, among other things, the approval of the Shareholders at the EGM.

As at the date of this announcement, there are 12,363,945,254 Existing Shares in issue which are fully paid or credited as fully paid. Assuming no further Shares will be issued or repurchased from the date of this announcement up to the effective date of the Share Consolidation, upon the Share Consolidation becoming effective, there will be 618,197,262 Consolidated Shares in issue which are fully paid or credited as fully paid.

GENERAL

The EGM will be convened and held for the Shareholders to consider and if thought fit, approve the Share Consolidation. To the best knowledge, information and belief of the Directors having made all reasonable enquiries, no Shareholder will be required to abstain from voting on the resolution in relation to the Share Consolidation at the EGM.

A circular containing, among other things, further information on the proposed Share Consolidation and a notice to convene the EGM are expected to be despatched to the Shareholders on or before Thursday, 17 July 2025.

PROPOSED SHARE CONSOLIDATION

The Board proposes to implement the Share Consolidation on the basis that every twenty (20) issued and unissued Existing Shares of HK\$0.10 each in the share capital of the Company will be consolidated into one (1) Consolidated Share of HK\$2.00.

Effects of the Share Consolidation

As at the date of this announcement, the authorised share capital of the Company is HK\$3,000,000,000 divided into 30,000,000,000 Existing Shares with a par value of HK\$0.10 each, of which 12,363,945,254 Existing Shares have been issued and are fully paid or credited as fully paid. Assuming that no further Shares will be issued or repurchased from the date of this announcement up to the effective date of the Share Consolidation, upon the Share Consolidation becoming effective, the authorised share capital of the Company shall be changed from HK\$3,000,000,000 divided into 30,000,000,000 Existing Shares of HK\$0.10 each to HK\$3,000,000,000 divided into 1,500,000,000 Consolidated Shares with a par value of HK\$2.00 each, of which 618,197,262 Consolidated Shares will be in issue and fully paid or credited as fully paid.

Upon the Share Consolidation becoming effective, the Consolidated Shares shall rank *pari passu* in all respects with each other.

Other than the expenses to be incurred in relation to the Share Consolidation, the implementation of the Share Consolidation will have no effect on the consolidated net asset value of the Group, nor alter the underlying assets, business operations, management or financial position of the Company or the proportionate interests or rights of the Shareholders, save that any fractional Consolidated Shares will not be allocated to Shareholders who may otherwise be entitled.

Conditions of the Share Consolidation

The implementation of the Share Consolidation is conditional upon:

- (i) the passing of an ordinary resolution by the Shareholders at the EGM to approve the Share Consolidation;
- (ii) the Listing Committee of the Stock Exchange granting the listing of, and permission to deal in, the Consolidated Shares arising from the Share Consolidation; and
- (iii) the compliance with all relevant procedures and requirements under the applicable laws of the Cayman Islands and Listing Rules to effect the Share Consolidation.

As at the date of this announcement, none of the conditions above had been fulfilled.

Subject to the fulfilment of the conditions of the Share Consolidation, the effective date of the Share Consolidation is expected to be on Monday, 25 August 2025, being the second Business Day after the date of the EGM.

Listing Application

An application will be made by the Company to the Listing Committee of the Stock Exchange for the listing of, and permission to deal in, the Consolidated Shares in issue and to be issued upon the Share Consolidation becoming effective.

Subject to the granting of the listing of, and permission to deal in, the Consolidated Shares on the Stock Exchange upon the Share Consolidation becoming effective, as well as compliance with the stock admission requirements of the HKSCC, the Consolidated Shares will be accepted as eligible securities by HKSCC for deposit, clearance and settlement in CCASS with effect from the commencement date of dealings in the Consolidated Shares on the Stock Exchange or such other date as determined by HKSCC. Settlement of transactions between participants of the Stock Exchange on any trading day is required to take place in CCASS on the second settlement day thereafter. All activities under CCASS are subject to the General Rules of CCASS and CCASS Operational Procedures in effect from time to time. All necessary arrangements will be made for the Consolidated Shares to be admitted into CCASS established and operated by HKSCC.

None of the Existing Shares are listed or dealt in on any other stock exchange other than the Stock Exchange, and at the time the Share Consolidation becomes effective, the Consolidated Shares in issue will not be listed or dealt in on any stock exchange other than the Stock Exchange, and no such listing or permission to deal is being or is proposed to be sought.

OTHER ARRANGEMENTS

Fractional entitlement to Consolidated Shares

Fractional Consolidated Shares arising from the Share Consolidation, if any, will be disregarded and will not be issued to the Shareholders but all such fractional Consolidated Shares will be aggregated and, if possible, sold and retained for the benefit of the Company. Fractional Consolidated Shares will only arise in respect of the entire shareholding of a holder of the Existing Shares regardless of the number of share certificates held by such holder.

Free exchange of share certificates for Consolidated Shares

Subject to the Share Consolidation becoming effective, which is currently expected to be Monday, 25 August 2025, being the second Business Day immediately after the date of the EGM, Shareholders may on or after Monday, 25 August 2025 and until Tuesday, 30 September 2025 (both days inclusive), submit their existing share certificates in brown colour for the Existing Shares to the Registrar, Tricor Investor Services Limited, at 17/F, Far East Finance Centre, 16 Harcourt Road, Hong Kong for exchange for new share certificates on the basis of every twenty (20) Existing Shares for one (1) Consolidated Share without any fractional Consolidated Share, in blue colour for the Consolidated Shares at the expense of the Company. It is expected that the new share certificates for the Consolidated Shares will be available for collection within 10 Business Days after

the submission of the existing share certificates to the Registrar for exchange. Thereafter, a fee of HK\$2.50 (or such other amount as may from time to time be allowed by the Stock Exchange) will be payable by the Shareholders to the Registrar for each share certificate for the Consolidated Shares issued or each share certificate for the Existing Shares submitted for cancellation, whichever is higher.

After 4:10 p.m. on Friday, 26 September 2025, trading will only be in Consolidated Shares which share certificates will be issued in blue colour. Existing share certificates in brown colour for the Existing Shares will cease to be valid for trading, settlement and registration purpose, but will remain valid and effective as documents of title.

Outstanding options, warrants or other securities

As at the date of this announcement, the Company has no outstanding options, warrants or other securities in issue which are convertible into or giving rights to subscribe for, convert or exchange into, any Existing Shares or Consolidated Shares, as the case may be.

Arrangement on odd lot trading

In order to facilitate the trading of odd lots (if any) of the Consolidated Shares arising from the Share Consolidation, the Company will appoint a securities firm to provide matching services, on a best effort basis, to those Shareholders who wish to acquire odd lots of the Consolidated Shares to make up a full board lot, or to dispose of their holding of odd lots of the Consolidated Shares. Details of the odd lot arrangement will be set out in the circular to be despatched to the Shareholders.

REASONS FOR THE PROPOSED SHARE CONSOLIDATION

Pursuant to Rule 13.64 of the Listing Rules, where the market price of the securities of an issuer approaches the extremities of HK\$0.01 or HK\$9,995.00, the issuer may be required either to change the trading method or to proceed with a consolidation or splitting of its securities. Further, the “Guide on Trading Arrangements for Selected Types of Corporate Actions” issued by Hong Kong Exchanges and Clearing Limited on 28 November 2008 and last updated on September 2024 states that (i) market price of the Shares at a level less than HK\$0.10 will be considered as trading at extremity as referred to under Rule 13.64 of the Listing Rules; and (ii) taking into account the minimum transaction costs for a securities trade, the expected board lot value per board lot should be greater than HK\$2,000.

In view of the prevailing trading prices of the Existing Shares, the Board proposes to implement the Share Consolidation. It is expected that the proposed Share Consolidation would bring about a corresponding upward adjustment in the trading price of the Consolidated Shares on the Stock Exchange. As a result, the proposed Share Consolidation would enable the Company to comply with the trading requirements under the Listing Rules. Based on the closing price of HK\$0.154 per Existing Share (equivalent to HK\$3.08 per Consolidated Share) as quoted on the Stock Exchange as at the date of this announcement, the expected market value of each board lot of 2,000 Consolidated Shares, assuming the Share Consolidation had become effective, would be HK\$6,160, which is greater than HK\$2,000 and therefore complies with the requirement as set out in the said “Guide on Trading Arrangements for Selected Types of Corporate Actions”.

Other than the expenses to be incurred in relation to the Share Consolidation, the implementation of the Share Consolidation will have no effect on the consolidated net asset value of the Group, nor alter the underlying assets, business operations, management or the financial position of the Company or the proportionate interests of the Shareholders. Although the Share Consolidation may lead to the creation of odd lots of Shares, the Company will appoint a securities firm as agent to provide matching services for odd lots of Shares for a period of not less than three weeks, which will alleviate the difficulties caused by the creation of odd lots of Shares. In view of the above, the Board considers that the Share Consolidation is fair and reasonable and in the interests of the Company and the Shareholders as a whole.

As at the date of this announcement, the Company has no intention to carry out other corporate actions in the next 12 months which may have an effect of undermining or negating the intended purpose of the Share Consolidation, and the Company does not have any plan, arrangement, understanding, intention, negotiation (either concluded or in process) on any fund raising activities or precise investment opportunities and has no immediate plan for issue of new Shares. However, the Board cannot rule out the possibility that the Company will conduct debt and/or equity fund raising exercises when suitable fund raising and/or investment opportunities arise in order to support future development of the Group. The Company will make further announcement in this regard in accordance with the Listing Rules as and when appropriate.
