SUMMARY OF ELECTRICITY GENERATION VOLUME OF POWER PLANTS FOR THE FOURTH QUARTER OF 2025

This announcement is made by Beijing Energy International Holding Co., Ltd. (the “**Company**”, collectively with its subsidiaries, the “**Group**”) to keep the shareholders and potential investors of the Company informed of the latest business development of the Group. The board of directors of the Company announces that according to the Group’s preliminary operation statistics, the 267 power plants beneficially owned by the Group and its associates have generated electricity in an aggregate volume of approximately 6,136,995 megawatt-hours (“**MWh**”) in the fourth quarter (“**Q4**”) of 2025, and the aggregate electricity generation volume for the twelve months ended 31 December 2025 has amounted to approximately 25,412,743MWh.

Details of the electricity generation volume statistics in Q4 of 2025 are summarised as below:

- (1) Some of the power plants of the Group increased grid-connection with further installed capacity of approximately 25MW in total in Q4 of 2025.
- (2) There was one solar power plant and one wind power plant self-constructed by the Group, which achieved grid-connection with total installed capacity of approximately 225MW in Q4 of 2025.
- (3) The Group completed an acquisition of one solar power plant which achieved grid-connection with installed capacity of approximately 460MW in Q4 of 2025.
- (4) The Group completed the disposals of the entire equity interest in three target companies which hold one solar power plant and two wind power plants with total installed capacity of approximately 239MW by the end of December 2025. The Group subsequently acquired 15% equity interests in these target companies which were recognised as associates of the Company.
- (5) The operation figures previously announced have been adjusted to be in line with the available accounting figures and to reflect the changes in our portfolio of power plants with effect from each transaction's respective completion date.
- (6) The figures provided herein are subject to rounding adjustment and will also be subject to other possible adjustments due to accounting procedures.

Shareholders and/or potential investors of the Company are hereby reminded that the information provided above merely represents the preliminary operating performance of the renewable energy power plants beneficially owned by the Group and its associates as of 31 December 2025 based on data currently available to the management, and is by no means a representation or a basis of reference or indication of the revenue or profit to be generated or derived by the Group or any financial performance of the Group in Q4 of 2025 or for the twelve months ended 31 December 2025.
