**POLL RESULTS OF THE EXTRAORDINARY GENERAL MEETING

The resolution as set out in the notice of the EGM was duly passed by way of a poll at the EGM held on 25 February 2019.

Reference is made to the circular (“**Circular**”) of Uni-Bio Science Group Limited (“**Company**”) dated 8 February 2019 in relation to the Transaction Arrangements. Unless otherwise specified, capitalised terms used in this announcement shall have the same meaning as those defined in the Circular.

The Board is pleased to announce that the resolution as set out in the notice of the EGM was duly passed by way of a poll at the EGM held on 25 February 2019.

As at the date of the EGM, there were a total of 6,179,968,147 Shares in issue. To the best of the Directors’ knowledge, information and belief having made all reasonable enquiries, save for (1) Mr. Leung and his associates, who together held 1,530,877,026 Shares; (2) Mr. Chen Dawei and his associates, who together held 330,955,516 Shares; and (3) Vital Vigour and its associates, who together held 873,360,000 Shares, each of which are required to abstain from voting on the resolution proposed at the EGM, no other Shareholder was required to abstain from voting on the resolutions proposed at the EGM. Accordingly, there were 3,444,775,605 Shares entitling the Shareholders to attend and vote on the resolution proposed at the EGM. Save as disclosed, none of the Shareholders was entitled to attend and abstain from voting in favour of the resolution proposed at the EGM according to Rule 13.40 of the Listing Rules. None of the Shareholders has stated their intention in the Circular to vote against the resolution proposed or to abstain from voting at the EGM.

The full text of the resolution was set out in the notice of the EGM dated 8 February 2019. The poll results of the resolution as follows:
