- (d) The total number of shares of the Company entitling the holder to attend and vote on resolutions numbered 1 to 3 and 7 and resolutions numbered 4 to 6 at the AGM was 4,353,966,228 shares and 3,790,776,188 shares.

- (e) There were no shares entitling the holder to attend and abstain from voting in favour of the resolutions at the AGM as set out in Rule 13.40 of the Rules Governing the Listing of Securities on The Stock Exchange of Hong Kong Limited (the “**Listing Rules**”).
- (f) As at the date of the AGM, China National Building Material Group Co., Ltd (“**CNBMG**”) and its associates, which together held 563,190,040 shares (representing approximately 12.94% of the issued shares), were considered to have a material interest in respect of the 2025 Mine Development Services Framework Agreement, the 2025 Engineering and Technical Services Framework Agreement and the 2025 Clinker and Cement Transactions Framework Agreements. As stated in the Company’s circular dated 25 April 2025, CNBMG and its associates were required to, and did, abstain from voting on resolutions numbered 4 to 6 in accordance with the Listing Rules. Save as disclosed above, no shareholder of the Company was required under the Listing Rules to abstain from voting on the resolutions at the AGM.
- (g) None of the shareholders of the Company have stated their intention in the Company’s circular dated 25 April 2025 to vote against or to abstain from voting on any of the resolutions at the AGM.
- (h) All directors attended the AGM.
- (i) The Company’s share registrar in Hong Kong, Computershare Hong Kong Investor Services Limited, acted as the scrutineer for the vote-taking at the AGM.
